Day 1: Bruges

Check-in a unique 15th-century former ducal residence in the historical center of Bruges

You will discover Bruges, the best preserved example of medieval Flanders. So picture postcard perfect is the city centre, known as 'the Venice of the North'. The entire historical city centre is an Unesco World Heritage site.

You board a carriage for a romantic ride along the canals and historical small bridges, relaxing to the gentle sound of the hoof beat of the horse. Along the way, you will find many small picturesque corners, several museums and other historical sites.

In the chocolate museum you will go on a journey of discovery through the rich history of chocolate in all its facets. You will learn how chocolate is made and why Belgian chocolate is so famous the world over. Then you will get to have a go themselves. The icing on the cake is that the workshop is rounded off with a tasting session accompanied by a glass of wine. Of course, you can take what was made for your family and friends to taste.

Day 2: Majestic Castle — North-sea — Marving Gay

The watery surroundings and the sheer tranquillity of the grounds in which it is set lend this pleasure palace a deep romantic sense of peace and well-being .

After this you will head to the North Sea. At the 'City by the Sea', sandy beaches invites you to delightful sunbathing, a brisk walk or a refreshing dip in the North Sea. After frolicking on the beach, you can take a walk down the promenade and royal galleries.

You halt for lunch at Brewery De Halve Maan, where panorama shots were taken from the roof top terrace.
